ProQuest Information and Learning is a global leader in collecting, organizing and distributing value-added information to researchers. **MLA International Bibliography** provides a classified listing and subject index for books and articles published on modern languages, literatures, folklore, and linguistics. It is compiled by the staff of the MLA Office of Bibliographic Information Services with the cooperation of more than 100 contributing bibliographers in the United States and abroad.

The *MLA International Bibliography* provides a classified listing and subject index for books and articles published on modern languages, literatures, folklore, and linguistics.

All electronic formats of the bibliography contain all entries in the print issues from 1963 to the present. It is searchable by classification headings, document authors, subject-index terms, language of the book or article, journal name, and other elements.

MLA International Bibliography has 1.6 M records and annually indexes over 66,000 books and articles.

Coverage includes literature from all over the world--Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, and North and South America. Folklore is represented by folk literature, music, art, rituals, and belief systems. Linguistics and language materials range from history and theory of linguistics, comparative linguistics, semantics, stylistics, and syntax to translation. Other topics include literary theory and criticism, dramatic arts (film, radio, television, theater), and history of printing and publishing.

Administration / Setup

The MLA International Bibliography is available as a standalone database under the Chadwyck-Healey brand and as an integrated, add-on module of Literature Online. Both resources are OpenURL enabled, which allows linking to a library's full-text holdings.

The Information Centre, accessible within the resource itself, offers easy access to durable URLs for journals, free downloadable MARC records, title lists, usage stats and marketing and user tools.
